### Chapel Hill Kindy Program

An important goal of the Chapel Hill Community Kindergarten is the development of social human beings. An atmosphere of real warmth and empathy amongst the children and adults is fostered.

Three- to five-year-old children have a lot to learn about how to get along with each other; about valuing themselves and others; about friendship; about kindness to all; and about peoples' similarities and differences. Our program offers a marvellous context for the development of these social and emotional skills as children go about their play having good fun, responding to conflict, and observing the behaviour of others while developing an awareness of their own.

Against a background of emerging self-control, sociability and growing emotional maturity, the highly qualified staff and thoughtfully designed and calm environment offer children an array of opportunities to develop their bodies' strength and dexterity; their abilities to think, imagine and express ideas and feelings; to increase their understanding of the world around them and the delights and obligations that awareness brings.

**Approved Kindergarten Program Providers**

This service holds a current service approval for a centre-based service in Queensland, under the Education and Care Services National Law (National Law) or the Education and Care Services Act 2013, and appropriate public liability insurance of at least \$10 million. To be eligible to receive kindergarten funding the service must meet specific requirements, including provide an approved kindergarten program:

- To children who are at least four years of age by 30 June in the year they commence kindergarten
- Delivered by a qualified early childhood teacher
- Aligned with the Queensland Kindergarten Learning Guideline, or other education program approved by the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority
- For 600 hours annually made up of 15 hours a week or 30 hours per fortnight for 40 weeks. Any other model must be approved by the Department of Education prior to commencement
