### Course Overview

The CHC50121 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care is a nationally recognised qualification from the CHC Community Service Training Package.

This qualification is for professionals who wish to take on a leadership role in an early childhood service and has a strong emphasis on advocacy for the rights of children; the development of strong relationships, effective workplace processes; inclusive, respectful, and responsive workplace culture; and curriculum which focuses on the needs of a child and their individual context.

A Diploma qualification in early childhood provides career opportunities beyond working directly with children, including leadership, management, and support roles. The course covers the following areas:

- Supporting the health, learning and development of children
- Supporting children's learning and development
- Design, planning, implementing, and evaluating educational programs
- Work with families, community, and external agencies
- Providing leadership and support to other staff
- Leadership roles in a variety of early childhood services
- Managing compliance with policies and legislation.
