About Our Kindergarten

Our kindy is a beautiful spacious timber pole building with large verandas and lots of shady areas for outdoor play. At Trinity Beach Community Kindergarten, we aim to create an environment that is safe, warm, relaxed and nurturing; ensuring children, their families and educators feel a sense of belonging.

Our kindy program incorporates rich learning environments that promote inquiry, choice, independence, confidence, communication and interaction. Outdoor learning environments including nature are valued for their importance in engaging the senses, teaching respectful interactions with the environment, developing problem solving and creative thinking, building connections with nature as well as supporting children's holistic learning and development.

What Happens in our Kindy Program?

Our kindergarten program is based upon the daily observed needs and interests of children, knowledge of child development and educational theories and current research. We follow the Queensland Kindergarten Guidelines and C&K's Curriculum Approach when planning and documenting children's learning and development.

We believe that children learn best through play and that play, and learning are intertwined. Our program is play based and child centred and provides opportunities for children to:

- Learn through exploration and play
- Develop social, emotional and relationship skills
- Develop independence, confidence and responsibility
- Ask questions, think critically and discover answers
- Develop problem solving and decision - making skills
- Assess and take 'safe risks' and develop resilience
- Develop physical skills (gross motor and fine motor)
- Develop language and literacy skills
- Develop mathematical and scientific thinking

When you walk into our kindy you may see children engaged in painting, pasting, drawing, puzzles, block building, dressing up, story reading, science investigations, cooking, climbing, balancing, gardening, sand and water play, running, singing and many other experiences.

Being Part of a Community Kindy

Trinity Beach Community Kindy is a non- profit community Early Childhood Kindergarten administered by a volunteer Management Committee. We are affiliated with the Creche and Kindergarten Association of Queensland. To be affiliated with C&K we must maintain high standards in regard to qualified teachers, programming, environments, equipment and safety.

Our families are an important part of our kindergarten. We respect and acknowledge our families as the child's primary educator. Our families support our kindy program by being involved in and participating in social and community events, working bees, kindy excursions and our Bush Kindy program.

Bush Kindy is an integral part of our kindy program. Trinity Beach Bush Kindy uses a natural outdoor environment to inspire children and offers children opportunities to achieve, develop confidence and a strong sense of wellbeing through hands on learning in nature.

Enrolment

Children are eligible for Kindy in the year before they are due to start Prep – 3 ½ to 4 ½ years old, turning 4 years old by 30 June of the kindy year.
